CEO Message



K-pop fans around the world,

Various stakeholders who have been with JYP on our journey,
I am pleased to share with you our inaugural Environmental, Social,
and Governance (ESG) Report – Leader of Change.

In 2021, JYP Entertainment recorded the highest annual album sales in its history despite the COVID-19 pandemic, with the combined total sales exceeding six million copies. We also successfully dropped the debut single for Xdinary Heroes, a band group with strong performances, in December 2021 and NMIXX, a girl group flaunting various charms, in February 2022. Backed by these achievements, sales in 2021 grew 34 percent year-on-year to a record high of KRW 193.8 billion, and operating profit rose by 31 percent to KRW 57.9 billion during the same period.

JYP Entertainment established JYP Three Sixty, a subsidiary to immerse into the IP/platform businesses, and in 2022, the company set up a North American arm called JYP USA in a bid to expand to the North American and global markets by establishing its presence in the US, which dominates the global pop music scene.

We have made improvement in terms of the independence of the Board of Directors (BOD) and gender equality policies through enabling the audit committee to serve as a check and balance on management and appointing new female directors.

Additionally, JYP Entertainment established the Compensation Committee and ESG Committee within the BOD so as to ensure that the executive compensation programs are appropriate and commensurate with performance results and that ESG framework is implemented and ESG management is incorporated into our business operations.

JYP Entertainment has built its business on the philosophy of "Integrity, Sincerity, Humility, and Love" for the past 25 years since its founding, and is proud to publish this inaugural ESG report, the first deliverable of the company's ESG management. Through this report, we intend to transparently disclose the company's management to our stakeholders, take the initiative in preserving the environment, promote partnerships for shared growth, and fulfill our role as a responsible corporate citizen.

Guided by our vision of "Leader in Entertainment," we will continue our journey of bringing joy to the people of the world and making it a better place with our music. We ask for your continued support and encouragement.

Creating ESG Vision and publishing inaugural ESG report



We have created the ESG vision "Leader of Change" for a sustainable future. The ESG Vision encompasses JYP Entertainment's determination to build a place where people who enjoy our music can unleash their dreams and realize their full potential together. It also represents our commitment to spread positive impacts to all our stakeholders, communities and even across the planet, which is the source and sustenance of our lives. In August 2022, it is based on this determination and commitment that we publish our first ever ESG report that highlights our ESG management approach and performances.

1st in entertainment industry to join RE100 ¹⁾



To mitigate climate change, JYP Entertainment has become the first Korean entertainment company to sign up for RE100. This means all albums recorded at the HQ in 2021 were made using 100 percent renewable energy. In 2021, we powered 100% of our electricity demand (1,393MWh) with solar PV energy, which reduced 640tCO2eq of green house gas emissions and brought us a step closer to Net Zero.

Bernard's ECOFriends series



We produced Bernard's ECOFriends as part of our environmental program and released it on JYP Entertainment's official YouTube channel. The series has eco-friendly contents where Bernard Park, a JYP artist, introduces green farming methods or does beach cleanup to raise environmental awareness. A total of 14 films were produced in seven months from May to December 2021.

Employee suggestion program "CHANGE" _



JYP Entertainment embraces a horizontal organizational culture. Employees address each other without honorific expressions for job titles, and flexible workplace strategies allow employees to work wherever and whenever they are most productive. In 2022, we rolled out the employee suggestion program called "CHANGE", to give everyone a simple way to voice their opinions regardless of their job title or function. Various ideas and suggestions from the employees are reviewed and incorporated into the company's policies and systems, thereby creating a better organizational culture at JYP Entertainment.

Employee Assistance Program



JYP Entertainment operates Employee Assistance Program to promote mental well-being and stress management and offers professional psychological counseling sessions for all members of the company – employees, artists, and trainees. We have extended the program to provide online sessions since the end of 2021, as well as face-to-face ones. Online counseling does not have space and time limitations and is particularly convenient for remote employees who work outside the office environment. Many other employees also utilize the online counseling program as it is less burdensome than in-person counseling.

Support for partners for shared growth _



We have laid out the JYP Partner Fair Cooperation Guideline to advocate the value of fair trade and shared growth. The guideline is the code of conduct that all partners of JYP Entertainment must follow, and guides us to practice transparent and ethical management with our partners. In addition, we operate communication channels for partners to freely present their ideas and make suggestions, and have built a partner support system to foster shared growth in a sustainable manner.

Training system for personality and talent development _____



JYP Entertainment discovers global talent through casting calls and auditions, and trains them to become all-round artists with good personality and character. The systematic curriculum includes not only courses to improve musical capabilities such as vocal, rap, dance, and composition, but also humanities forum and gender equality education. We also provide support in various areas, such as health checkups, strength training and exercise, organic diet, and psychological counseling.

Expanding EDM social contribution projects overseas

JYP Entertainment earmarks three percent of its operating profit from the previous year for social contribution projects. The EDM medical treatment project is our flagship CSR program, in which we provide medical treatment costs for children from lower income families. In 2020 and 2021, we donated KRW 450 million in total and supported 41 children. Taking a step further, in 2021, we signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with international NGO World Vision and donated KRW 300 million, expanding the reach of the EDM program overseas. JYP JAPAN also participated in the project and supported 313 overseas children in Mongolia, the Philippines, Bangladesh, and Vietnam.

Increasing ratio of female directors to 25%, independent directors to 50%

We have bolstered the diversity of the board of directors (BOD) by appointing a female independent director in 2022 and thereby raising the ratio of female directors in the BOD to 25 percent. The independence of the BOD has also been improved with independent directors now accounting for 50 percent of the BOD.

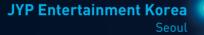

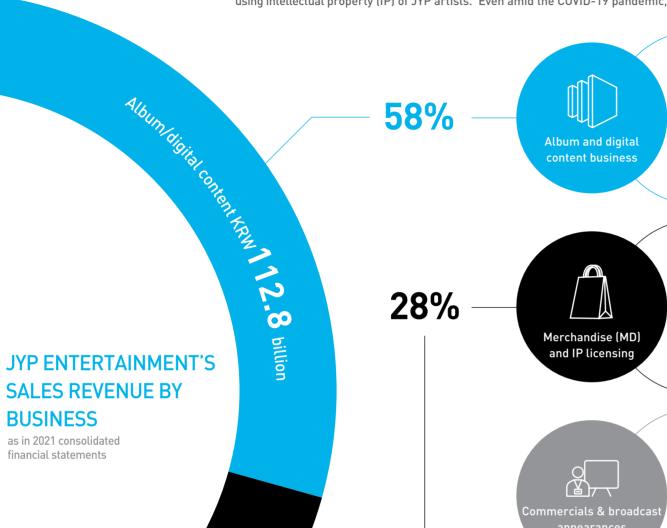

JYP Business

At JYP Entertainment, we leverage our unrivaled talent discovery & training system and music & performance production as our core competencies and operate in three primary businesses: Album/digital content, performances & concerts, and licensing using intellectual property (IP) of JYP artists. Even amid the COVID-19 pandemic,

we have ventured to launch a new channel for online live performances, while continuing to expand our business through forging cooperative partnerships, as artists perform overseas more frequently with K-Pop's recent global rise.



Despite the downward trend in the global recorded music industry, JYP Entertainment has witnessed a steady increase in album sales for its artists since 2015 along with the growing fanbase centered on the domestic and Japanese market. We have our own in-house music production infrastructure and an impressive roaster of producers and songwriters with successful track records under JYP Publishing, including executive producer JY Park. In addition, in line with the global rise of the K-Pop industry, the overseas activities of our artists have increased, and the demand for our music, which was limited to specific countries such as Korea and Japan, is now spreading to other overseas regions. Responding to such changes, JYP Entertainment has entered into partnerships with major international record labels and distributors, such as Sony Music, TME (Tencent Music Entertainment), Republic Records, and Orchard to expand, the global distribution channels for our music content.

We have formed a dedicated management organization for each artist early on from the debut for more coordinated management and marketing activities, and engaged in the direct service business based on the recognition and stardom of the artists, and the licensing business leveraging their intellectual property (IP). This business has been growing since 2016 when the company expanded the artist line-up following organizational and process improvements. In the case of licensing businesses using IP, the value and demand is expanding due to the scalability of the business and the overall growth of the content industry. Utilizing this, we release various digital content and music content, including those uploaded on YouTube, and also sell artist merch products as part of our core business. In July 2021, we established JYP Three Sixty with the aims to focus on MD sales and IP businesses and enhance platform-based global distribution, thereby strengthening connection and bond with global fandoms. In 2022, led by JYP Three Sixty, JYP Shop was launched as the first online MD mall, to meet global demand by introducing various merch products including albums and content in various languages. More recently, we have been expanding the IP licensing business through forging various collaborative partnerships, including Naver Z, a Naver subsidiary that runs metaverse platform Zepeto.

JYP Entertainment provides management and promotion services for our artists at home and abroad, including TV shows, TV series/ films, commercials, online content, and radio shows. We schedule by prioritizing programs that can help promote newly-released albums most effectively and considering artists' characteristics and capabilities. In addition, through an expert organization with more than 20 years of broadcast casting experience, we focus on preventing a wide range of risks that may occur in the casting process in advance and selecting the most efficient content for improving artist's image. In line with the recent trend, we leverage online channels, including YouTube, as a medium to meet and communicate with fans, along with the traditional channels such as music broadcasts, awards ceremonies, radio shows, and various entertainment programs.

Performances & concert management

management

JYP Entertainment, which has a global fandom, conducts concert tours in domestic and overseas regions, and generates stable guarantee revenue through ticket sales or performance copyrights sales and secondary value through DVD production and online live viewing copyright sales. In 2021, however, the performance and concert sales plummeted to 1/20 of the 2019 scale due to the restrictions on offline performances amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. Undaunted by the challenge, we jointly launched the online concert platform "Beyond LIVE" in an attempt to create a new form of online live performance that has never been tried before. Virtual performances hosted on the "Beyond LIVE" platform have been received well among fans. For example, the virtual concerts held in 2020 for TWICE and Stray Kids utilized the augmented reality (AR) technology to add virtual elements such as light sticks and audience seats, and inserted sound of crowds cheering. We not only brought satisfaction to the concertgoers in the absence of live music performances to enjoy in person, but also delivered unique virtual experience enabled by implementing various AR stage effects and backdrops to the audiences around the world without physical hurdles. In addition, when we resumed in-person performances with a phased easing of COVID-19 restrictions, we held online concerts in parallel and created added value over multiple layers.

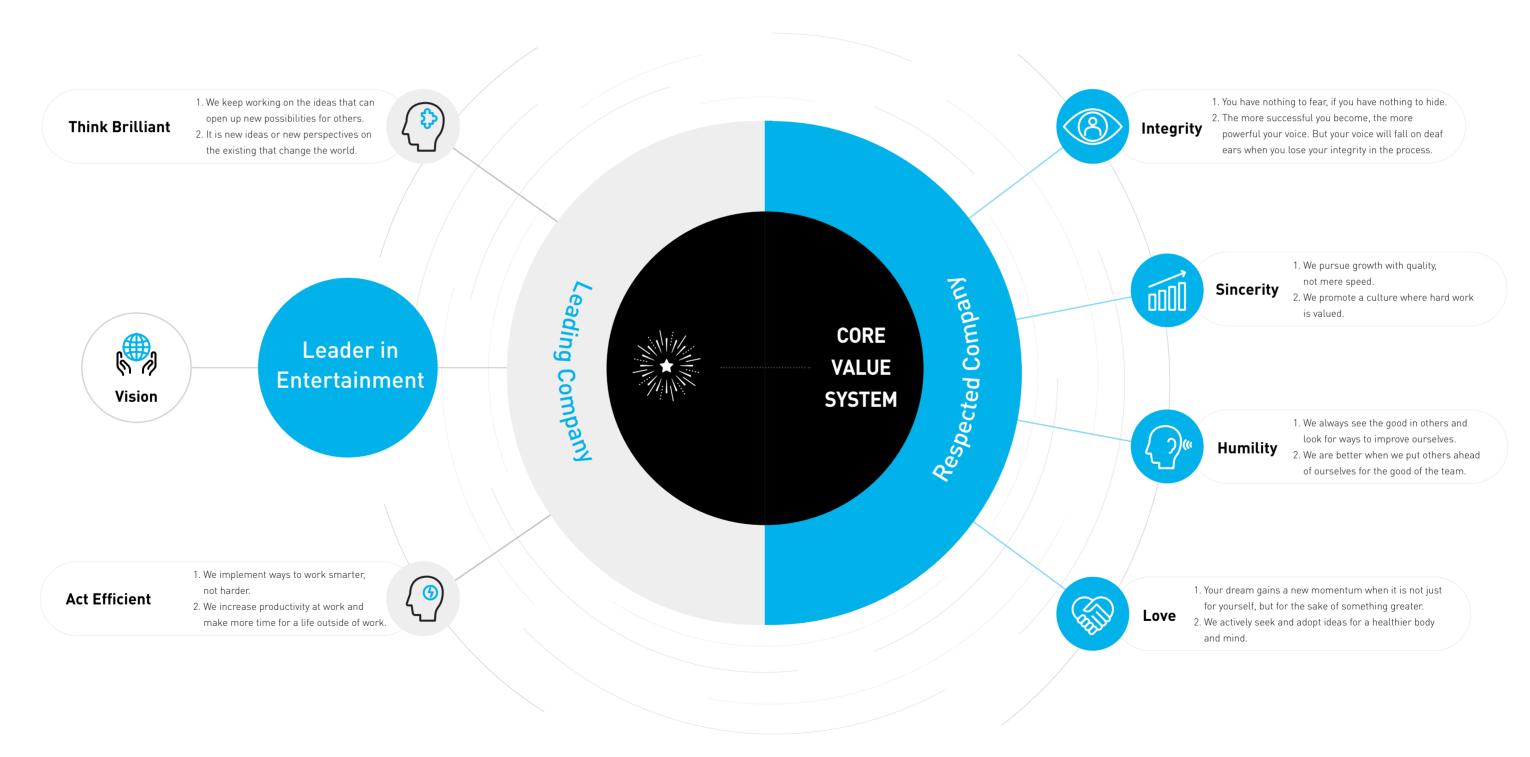

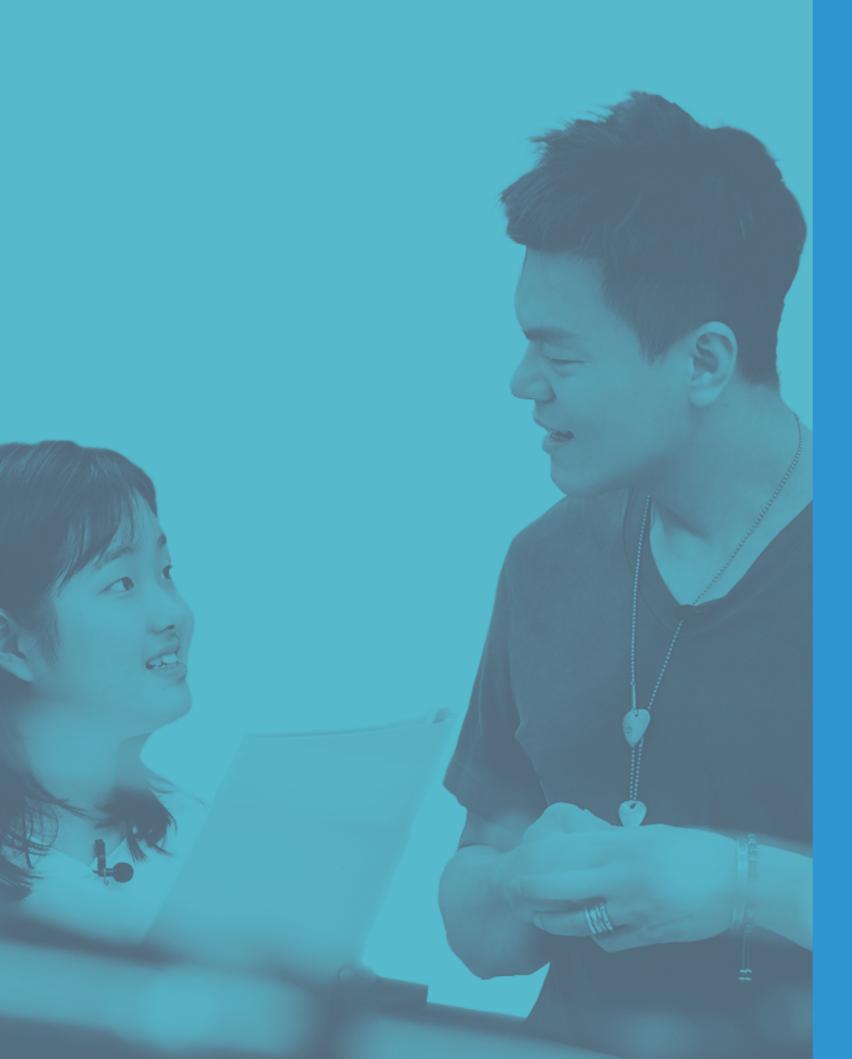

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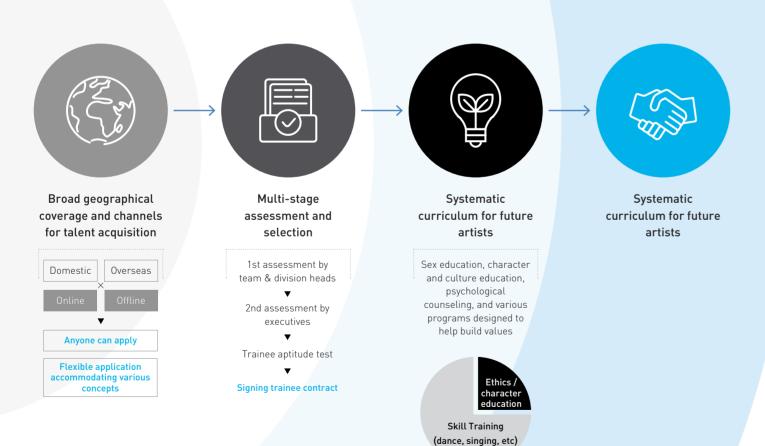
Artist Incubation

'Talent discovery and development system designed to fostering artists with good personality'

At JYP Entertainment, we have long been implementing and constantly improving differentiated criteria for selecting artists and trainees. Our systematic approach to training helps artists develop competence, and nurture good personality and positive attitude.

About JYP casting calls / auditions

Casting / Audition

JYP Entertainment is actively looking for rising talent through various casting activities and auditions. Based on the annual business plan, we carry out official annual audition, special auditions, and monthly auditions to find talented people from around the world. Furthermore, we welcome year-round applications through our online audition website and SNS channels for online casting calls.

Differentiated trainee selection criteria

As part of our trainee selection process, we conduct several steps to see if applicants have the qualities we look for. We meet with each applicant for a separate aptitude Q&A session, and seek to better understand the emotional state of trainees through a personality test program that reflects experts' opinions. This multi-faceted assessment process forms the very foundation of JYP's unrivaled artist incubation system, and also plays a key role in signing potential artists with the qualities and personality the company pursues early on from the audition stage.

In-house platform for auditions

In 2010, JYP Entertainment rolled out its own online audition webpage (audition.jype.com), and has since been operating the platform so anyone can submit their application anytime, anywhere, regardless of age, gender, or nationality. Even in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, we continued on with auditions in line with the non-face-to-face trend. We plan and conduct auditions more creatively and freely on the online platform, meeting hundreds of applicants with various talents every day.

Official annual audition program with tradition and history

JYP Entertainment has grown into a total entertainment company that boasts long history and tradition in the Korean pop music and moves the global K-Pop culture. At the center of the tradition lies JYP's official annual audition program, which began in 2007 and has since discovered so many artists including Wooyoung (2PM), Baek Yerin, Jay B and Jinyoung (GOT7), Nayeon and Jeongyeon (TWICE), Seungmin (Stray Kids), and Jungsu (Xdinary Heroes). Our official

annual audition is Korea's one and only audition program that creates a virtuous cycle, in which the audition produces many artists, and that in turn attracts more aspiring talent who wants to become next breakout stars.

Training

JYP Entertainment's training system that turns raw talent selected through casting calls and auditions into artists is our growth engine and core competitive edge. The well-thought-out curriculum helps trainees improve their vocal and performance skills and also learn about horizontal communication and competition in good faith, serving as a "steppingstone" to grow into all-round artists.

Promoting physical & mental health

Health checkups are provided to all trainees every two years. We also support growth and nutrition programs for trainees with delayed growth. Furthermore, healthy and nutritious meals (JYP BOB) with organic ingredients are offered for free at the in-house restaurant to all trainees who are still growing. We aim to create a positive training environment through the periodic individual counseling sessions, surveys using Google Forms, anonymous communication channel (JYP_TALK), and counseling with professional psychological counselors.

Promoting horizontal culture & two-way communication

JYP Entertainment respects and promotes human rights of trainees and aims for a horizontal culture where two-way communication between trainers and trainees is encouraged, instead of instructions

and commands being transmitted unilaterally through a vertical hierarchy. To this end, We have in place the "Trainer-Trainee Program" that matches every trainee to a trainer for closer engagement so that there are no trainees left out.

Good faith competition driving artists' growth

At JYP Entertainment, all trainees are evaluated through competence/attitude assessments every month, JYP PARTY (club performance) three times a year, and JYP SHOWCASE (stage performance) twice a year. This is part of JYP's continued effort to provide a fair environment for trainees to compete in good faith and grow into competent artists with good personality.

Support in the run-up to debut

Once decision is made to debut a group, the company forms a project group by finalizing the line-up and then focuses on forging teamwork among the members as well as honing skills of each member. Through collaboration with the Artist Division, the project group goes through the customized training phase where each member fine-tunes vocal, dance, choreography, and self-written rap skills, depending on their position in the group, and receives feedback for further practice. Additionally, we conduct in-depth individual interviews at least three times with the finalized trainees to encourage and guide them to carry responsibility for their words and actions since debut is to reveal oneself in front of a large number of people.

Supporting artists after debut

JYP Entertainment provides a wide range of supports for artists so that they unleash their full potential and pursue their dreams. After making a debut, artists can utilize JYP's systematic support to grow in various fields, and continue to foster the values of Leader's Code through periodic in-depth interviews.

Well-thought-out management services

Signed artists are assigned to one of the labels and have full access to systematic support and management services. There are full-time support staff who periodically communicate with label leader and members and keep track of artists' competency building status as well as physical and mental well-being, so as to help artists stay

healthy, active and motivated.

We do our utmost to enhance well-being and quality of life of artists in various ways, providing accommodations, coordinating schedules, and supporting counseling sessions and vacations.

Support for artists' growth

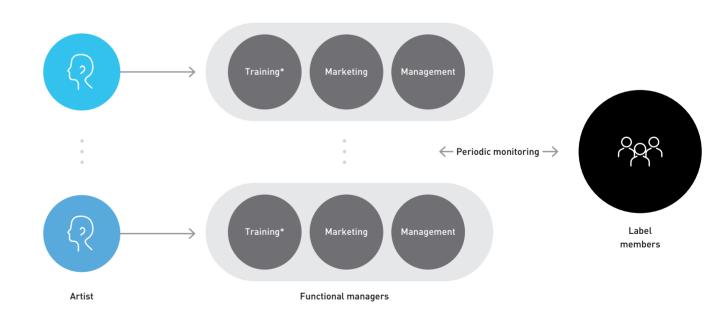
Each artist sets the direction of his desired long-term growth and constantly discusses this with the label members. The label then considers the direction the artist wants to explore and individuality of the artist, and provides various training programs accordingly so that the artist can play up strengths and improve areas of weaknesses, broadening his musical spectrum as artist. In particular, as artists' influence in our society and global fandoms are growing, more focus is being placed on character qualities of individual artists as public figures. Recognizing this, JYP Entertainment offers

training programs covering various fields such as foreign languages, society, and culture, along with vocal and performance trainings. Our proactive and horizontal competency development process is instrumental in fostering well-rounded artists.

Cultivating personality and ethical values based on Leader's Code

We hold in-depth interviews with every artist two to three times a year. This serves as an opportunity to remind artists of the ethical values in Leader's Code and to motivate them to go one step further. Artists meet with Executive Producer J.Y. Park for the first in-dept interview right after their debut and discuss their ambitions and plans. Subsequent periodic interviews are heart-to-heart talks over what they have felt and learned and what challenges they have had serving as an opportunity for artists to mull over and reflect upon their personal development.

'Start with your heart, Finish with your brain'

"Start with your heart, Finish with your brain" is a phrase that encapsulates how we go about creating something. It is when inspiration touches the heart that artists start working on a project. But they strive to create something that will be loved and remembered for a long period of time by thoroughly analyzing them and improving the degree of perfection to the details. JYP Entertainment brings to life unparalleled performance by leveraging its team of talented songwriters and choreographers, flexible creative structure, and top-tier production infrastructure.

Music Production

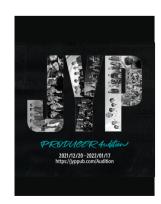
With the aim to become the "Leader in Entertainment," JYP Entertainment works relentlessly to make the music we pursue, and at the center of our effort lies the Music Production System, which is based on JYP 2.0. JYP Entertainment's unique Music Production System consists of a flexible creative structure, global producing, and creative infrastructure that allows to create music as best as we can.

Flexible creative structure

Currently, JYP Entertainment operates five independent artist labels, each of which has autonomy over its respective artists, planning and producing all music and content independently. This flexible structure is proven to be instrumental in delivering diverse content more promptly and engaging better with fandom. In addition, each label makes original and creative content through close cooperation with JYP Publishing.

JYP Publishing positions itself as a creative leader in the music content industry in Korea by sharing accumulated producing data and know-how with its songwriters to create something new. JYP Publishing's experienced producers team up with their counterpart in each label and make groundbreaking music and content. The company also takes the lead in protecting intellectual property rights for their creations.

JYP Publishing fostering talented songwriters



JYP Publishing is a music publisher under the JYP Entertainment banner, which was founded by producer J.Y. Park in 2008. Since 2012, JYP Publishing has hosted a public audition for new songwriters every year, providing opportunities to debut as an official songwriter through fair competition regardless of experience. Winners who make it through the final round are provided with personalized training and support to grow their career as a songwriter. Songwriters housed at JYP Publishing develop their skills and professional attitude through mentoring and collaborating with other songwriters as well as conducting research on current trends in music.

Songwriters under JYP Publishing can work with a sense of belonging as they can utilize the data owned by the company or exchange quality information amongst themselves. JYP Publishing ensures its members also gain additional benefit as copyright owners by releasing creative works and signing licensing agreements. For JYP Entertainment, having such a thriving creative community that deeply understands JYP's direction and suggests musical trends is so critical for content production, which is the bedrock of the entertainment industry.

Global producing

JYP Entertainment has applied "Globalization by Localization" strategy to bring in overseas talent and produce original music that appeals to local audiences. Through this system, BOY STORY successfully debuted in China and NiZiU in Japan. We continuously expand our musical spectrum through overseas projects to train and launch local K-POP artists who have cultural familiarity and popular appeal.

Best music production facilities

We provide an optimal environment for music production to improve the quality of the content itself, as well as the diversity of content and the efficiency of production. Equipped with 9 vocal rooms, 16 production rooms, and 11 recording studios, our in-house facilities provide all the workspaces necessary for the creative process, so that artists and producers can immerse themselves into their projects to develop their skills or interact with others and to create the best results.

Performance Production

JYP Entertainment has resident choreographers who have accumulated over 10 years of choreography creation know-how and stage experience, and a separate performance creation team called Performance Directing LAB. To create an optimal performance, choreographers closely participate in the entire album production process from the training of the artists.

Creative work by in-house choreographers

At JYP Entertainment, resident choreographers are deployed to the Performance Directing Lab to create unique JYP choreography styles and help artists practice the style of dance they choreograph. Resident choreographers merge many years of choreographic experience and stage experience with JYP's directions to develop unique performances. Choreographers also identify artists' preferences and needs from practicing together before their debut and come up with dance pieces that highlight their strengths. During the creative choreographic process, we closely communicate with the artists and Artist Division to make sure the choreography fits in with everything else, such as the general concept of the album, costume, and artists' style.

Storytelling through performance

One of the focuses we emphasize for our projects is that the choreography should be able to convey the story and message of the song, and that the album and performance should tell the story consistently. Choreographers hold several meetings with the Artist Division and decide on a keyword that matches well with the artist and album. We then make sure the keyword runs through the music, choreography, music video, and costumes, and the storyline of the lyrics is also echoed with choreography. We aim to create effective choreography by aligning key movement elements to the lyrics, as was the case with the J.Y. Park's "swimming dance," TWICE's "TT dance," and ITZY's "shoulder dance".

Creating organic choreography

Resident choreographers not only create dance works, but then direct the performances of JYP artists. As we do not rely on external directors for one-off event, all performances JYP puts together are interconnected to form a greater worldview. Our goal is to shape the stories artists want to convey into an organic choreography on stage.

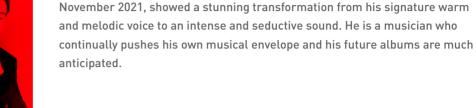

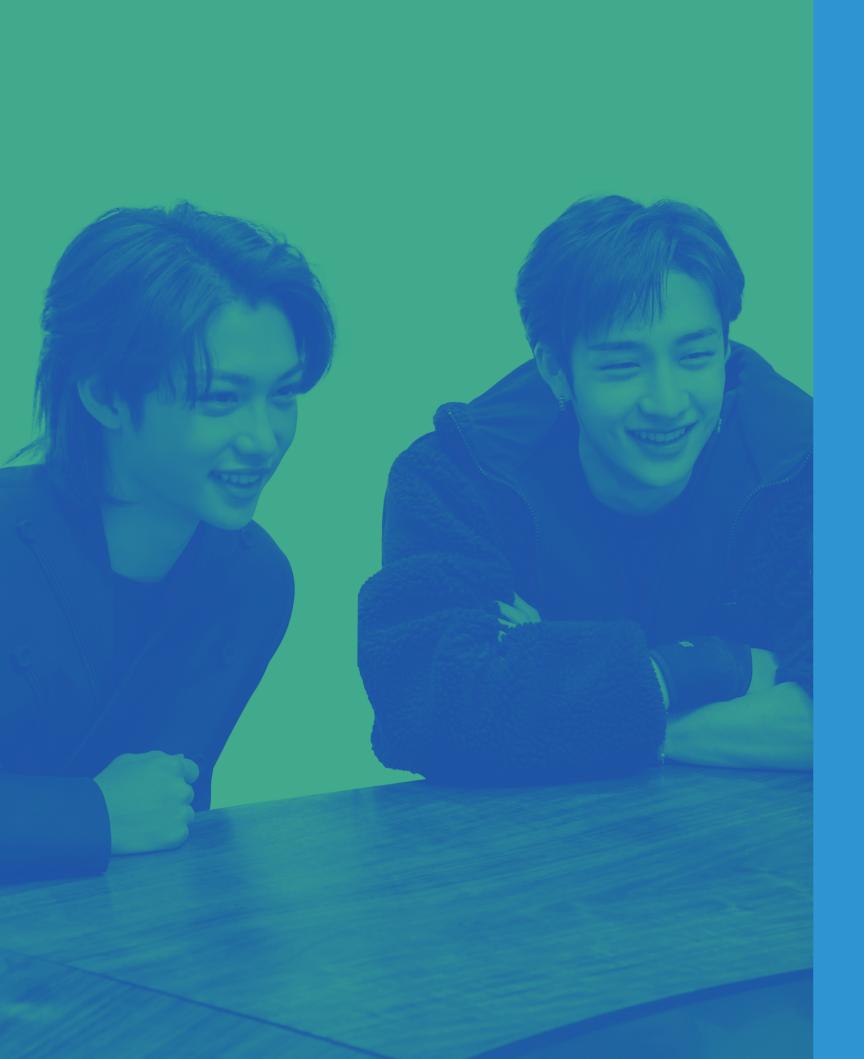

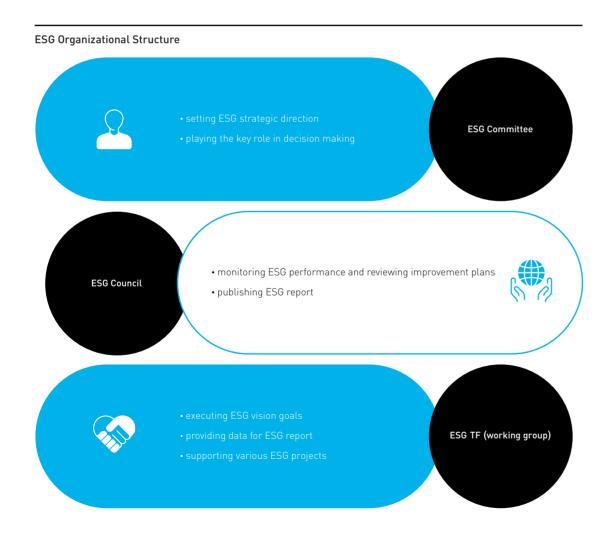

The ESG Committee plays a pivotal role in setting the direction of our medium- to long-term ESG strategy and making key decisions. The ESG Council is responsible for establishing/monitoring ESG management plans based on the medium- to long-term ESG direction, minimizing associated risks, and seeking out new business opportunities. And the ESG Taskforce (working group), which consists of functional representatives, closely communicates with the ESG Council depending on the agenda and executes ESG strategies linked to each function, thereby ensuring the ESG goals are attained.

Background

The international community is paying more attention to environmental issues nowadays in line with the growing awareness of the need to transition to an environmentally sustainable society to cope with climate change. A lot of environmental regulations are being established or reinforced as human sustainability is under threat, as evidenced by mounting signs: ozone layer depletion, environmental pollution, and resource depletion to name a few. In light of the current challenges, companies are called on to adopt a new paradigm of corporate management to fulfill their growing environmental responsibility. The entertainment industry is no exception in this respect. In addition to the demand for carbon neutrality, there is a growing voice in our industry advocating active participation of stakeholders who create and consume our music in environmental impact reduction efforts.

Direction

JYP Entertainment has established the environmental management system to set and manage environmental impact reduction goals. We are actively reducing our carbon footprint by shifting to renewable energy and continuously managing our environmental impact with the aim of achieving Net Zero for JYP Entertainment's entire creative ecosystem. Furthermore, we drive climate change awareness of the public by launching environmental campaigns featuring JYP artists for K-Pop fans around the world and for a sustainable future.

Environmental management system

Recognizing the seriousness of environmental pollution and climate change, JYP Entertainment strives to incorporate environmental impact to all management activities and start working on what we can do to protect the environment. In this regard, we have set environmental management objectives aimed at minimizing environmental impacts and continue to carry out eco-friendly activities accordingly.

Direction for environmental management

We take a two-pronged approach to environmental management: responding to climate change and promoting environmental value. With regard to climate change response, our goal is to minimize our footprint across the board by conserving energy and switching to renewable energy sources. In the future, we will further accelerate our effort by proactively managing greenhouse gas [GHG] emissions and seeking verification.

As for environmental value promotion, JYP is working to cut back on waste and use eco-friendly ingredients at its in-house restaurant and cafe. Externally, we look to increase environmental awareness in our society in general, through participating in global environmental networks, producing environmental content featuring JYP artists, and hosting campaigns in which fans and artists participate.

Environmental management organization

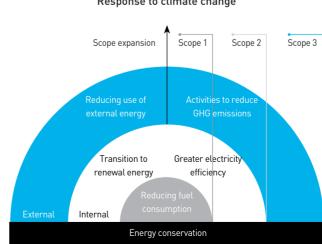
JYP Entertainment has established a taskforce for environmental management under the ESG Council in order to enable a systematic and swift response to environmental issues. The environmental management taskforce sets energy conservation objectives every year, and continuously monitors the progress. Moreover, the organization is accountable for planning and executing a variety of programs to promote environmental values through close cooperation with the Artist Division.

Environmental management organization structure

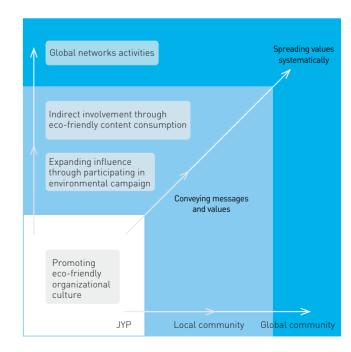

Response to climate change

JYP Entertainment makes efforts to use renewable energy and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions while managing in-house energy consumption, in order to protect the environment and preserve the planet for our future generations to fully realize their dream.

Energy conservation

We manage and monitor the annual energy consumption, and actively implement measures to conserve energy. As part of such effort, in July 2020, we installed energy-efficient hot water boilers to reduce city gas consumption. This energy efficiency measure resulted in a 14% reduction of city gas usage from 698GJ in 2020 to 600GJ in 2021.

Transition to renewable energy

To cope with the climate crisis, over 370 global companies are voluntarily participating in the green initiative of RE100 to source 100 percent of their power from renewable energy, and the Korean government is also actively promoting RE100 with the goal of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050. As a member of the global initiative, in 2021, JYP Entertainment powered 100% of our electricity demand (1,393MWh) with solar PV energy. In other words, this means all albums recorded at the HQ in 2021 were made using 100 percent renewable energy. The conservation can be translated into a 640tCO2eq reduction of GHG emissions, and brings us a step closer to Net Zero.

To achieve this, JYP Entertainment purchased renewable energy certificates (REC) under agreements with domestic solar power plants, becoming the first Korean entertainment company to fulfill RE100.

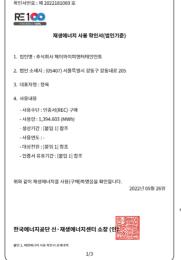
About RE100

RE100 is an acronym for "Rene wable Electricity 100%", and is a voluntary campaign in which an enterprise commits to 100% renewable electricity either

Renewable energy here refers to energy generated from PV, wind, hydroelectric power, geothermal energy, and any other natural source that can be used as alternative to fossil fuels. Launched in 2014 by the Climate Group and the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP), RE100 brings together over 370 global companies including Google, Apple, and Nike. Among domestic companies are SK, Amorepacific, KB Financial Group, and K-water.

Promotion of environmental value

Activities to reduce environmental footprint

The environmental conservation is a global issue that calls for global action and global solidarity. JYP Entertainment implements a wide range of programs within the organization and outside of it to reduce its environmental footprint.

Environmentally-friendly albums and merchandise

JYP Entertainment is serious about reducing the environmental impact of its content. We are working on various digital-only albums to replace physical CDs to reduce waste associated with physical album purchases. Fans purchasing albums in the future will only receive physical photo cards while being granted to access to all other included material such as songs, behind-the-scene content and lyrics through a digital code, and for this purpose, related technologies such as QR and NFC are being reviewed. We are also considering eco-friendly production options for photo cards.

In parallel, we will redesign album packaging to minimize packaging materials and adopt FSC-certified paper, soy ink and eco-friendly coating materials in order to address the pollution problem posed by album packaging.

We are looking to phase in eco-friendly merchandise as well. We will actively utilize green materials such as biodegradable plastic made from nature and upcycling products using discarded waste, and expand the reusable products that can be reused several times, such as clothes, eco-bags and tumblers using natural materials. To this end, we will also work hard to create social value by reviewing cooperation with social enterprises and social ventures in various ways.

As such, JYP Entertainment is creating a K-pop culture where the entertainment industry and the environment can continue to co-exist through creating content that promotes environmental value.

Operating eco-friendly cafe JYP-Soulcup

JYP-Soulcup is our in-house café and an eco-friendly complex cultural space, driven by its motto "Love You More, Love Earth". Through the cafe, we aim to practice sustainability-led behavior in every aspect of the business, from purchasing raw materials to operation.

JYP-Soulcup uses eco-friendly ingredients and materials wherever possible to minimize its impact on the environment. By increasing the proportion of organic and pesticide-free raw materials up to 80%, we reduced the environmental impact of the material purchasing process. We also use eco-friendly materials in our manufacturing and packaging stages to reduce our carbon footprint and plastic waste. Disposable plastic (PP) was replaced with eco-friendly plastic (PLA), and regular paper cups were replaced with paper cups made of sugar cane and bamboo pulp.

Meanwhile, we encourage the use of reusable containers rather than disposable cups as a way to reduce waste. We aim to increase the proportion of tumbler use by 20% through customer discounts and campaigns, and reduce 12,000 disposable cups per year through active use of multi-use containers.

Operating 'JYP BOB', on-site restaurant with minimal environmental impact

JYP BOB is a cafeteria for JYP employees and artists, and we participate in environmental impact reduction activities by providing an eco-friendly diet and minimizing food waste.

We use eco-friendly ingredients that are organic, pesticide-free, and antibiotic-free, and choose eco-friendly products wherever possible to minimize the impact on the environment. Also, utensils and cutlery that emit environmental hormones are not used.

In a bid to reduce food waste, we operate a reservation system, small-amount staggered cooking, and buffet line setup. We also encourage employees to join our efforts through self-dispensing, allowing them to take only as much food as needed. Unavoidable food waste is collected by recycling companies for composting, and a food disposal performance report is submitted every year. We make sure waste cooking oil is also treated in an eco-friendly manner through a service provider.

Promotion of environmental value

Participating in the global environmental network 1% for the Planet

1% for the Planet is a global environmental network of businesses, non-profits, and individuals who work together for a healthy planet. JYP Entertainment has been a member since 2020 and working in solidarity with domestic and foreign environmental organizations to solve environmental problems. By donating 1% of the sales of the in-house café JYP-Soulcup to Our Sea of East Asia Network (OCEAN), we strive to protect the marine environment. Donation was used to publish "Impacts of Marine Litter on Biodiversity II> and distribute it to 29 government agencies, including Korea Maritime Environment Management Corporation, National Institute of Fisheries Science, and Korea Maritime Institute, and we posted the publication in the PDF format on our website to raise awareness of marine litter.

About One Percent for the Planet

Founded in 2002 by Yvon Chouinard, the founder of Patagonia, and Craig Mathews, the founder of Blue Ribbon Flies, 1% Percent for the Planet is a global network of responsible businesses tackling our planet's most pressing environmental issues. Only when the environmental issues.



ronmental problems are addressed at the regional level can they be addressed at the country level, and then, at the global level. 1% for the Planet member companies donate 1% of their annual sales to local grassroots environmental organizations. As a member of 1% for the Planet, JYP Entertainment donated 1% of JYP-Soulcup sales to Our Sea of East Asia Network (OCEAN) to promote the importance of protecting the global environment.

Artist's Environmental Project : "Bernard's ECOFriends"

JYP Entertainment practices environmental protection and promotes our activities to share our values with everyone to build a healthier place to live. As part of such effort, we produced Bernard's ECOFriends, which sheds light on the activities of those who strive to protect the Earth.

Bernard's ECOFriends is a project where JYP artist Bernard Park introduces what we can do to save the planet and conveys the value. For seven months from May to December 2021, we selected different environmental themes every month, including eco-friendly farming methods, urban beekeeping, beach cleanup, and native seeds, and produced a total of 14 films, one artist experience episode and a song cover each per theme. Other JYP artists and environmental activists joined as guests to help raise awareness of the importance of activities and encourage the participation of fans and the public.

The videos were released on JYP Entertainment's official YouTube channel and shared with people interested in the environment and all users of JYP Entertainment's music content.

Through such content that combines music and nature, we exerted a positive influence on those who were interested in environmental issues but did not know where to start.

Environmental campaign "Love Earth Challenge"

Since 2020, JYP Entertainment has been organizing Love Earth Challenge, an environmental campaign to revive the earth for life so that everyone can lead a healthy life and pursue their dream. The challenge also commemorates the International Coastal Cleanup Day every year by proposing specific initiatives to protect the marine environment, which has become the final destination for waste. JYP artists and fans participate in the SNS campaign to raise marine environmental awareness and take actions to protect the earth.

In 2020, we encouraged the use of tumblers, which can be easily practiced in daily life, by holding the TUMBLER FOR EARTH challenge on SNS, and JYP artists and 840 fans participated in the challenge. In addition, in 2021, we organized the CLEAN SWELL campaign, in which 1,100 artists and fans picked up garbage and properly separated it for the purpose of reducing the amount of garbage being discharged into the sea. In order to bring about a more substantial change, JYP matched the number of posts in the campaign and the number of views for the episode 4 of Bernard's ECOFriends, Bernard protects the sea, with KRW 30 million in donation to Our Sea of East Asia Network (OCEAN). This donation was used to clean up 21 beaches and the Han River in Seoul, collecting a total of 4,731 kg of garbage. Going forward, all employees and artists of JYP Entertainment will sincerely participate in environmental protection activities, contributing to keeping our planet healthy.

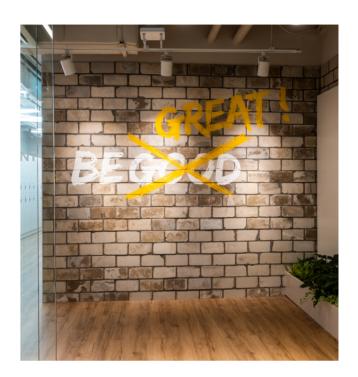
Employees

Talent recruitment

JYP Entertainment believes people are the most valuable asset for a company, and does its best to recruit and develop talented people. People are our core growth engine and play a vital role in making the company a leader in the entertainment business.

At JYP Entertainment, key senior management participates in the hiring process to recruit talented people who have good personality as well as practical skillsets, and a personality test is given to assess candidates from various angles. Furthermore, we adopt a blind recruitment process for creative positions to focus more on individuals' creativity and ensure fairness.

More staff come on board as the company grows, and we plan to increase recruitment in 2022. In contrast, employee turnover rate declined and was nine percent as of the first half of 2022. We expect the average tenure to gradually increase accordingly.

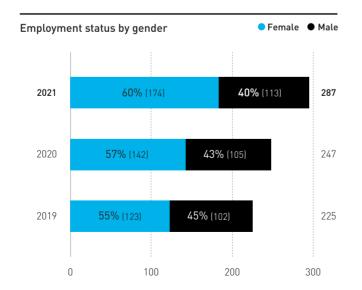

Employee diversity

JYP Entertainment is a company where talented people are gathered to blossom, achieve their dreams, and grow with the company. As of the first half of 2022, we have a total of 295 employees, of which 96 percent, or 285 employees, work on a full-time basis. We look out for people with both creativity and good personality, and work hard to cultivate a culture that respects all employees as talent. We are creating an environment where talented people with diverse backgrounds and experiences can make creative music and content with flexible thinking.

JYP Entertainment has endeavored to build a workplace where female talent can grow. As of the first half of 2022, about 62 percent of the workforce was female. In addition, a female executive director was appointed in 2021 to strengthen the leadership of female talent, and 75 percent of the newly appointed team heads in 2022 were female, raising the ratio of female managers to 42 percent as of the first half of 2022. Going forward, we will continue to implement work-life balance policies such as parental leaves and encourage female employees to grow their career into leadership positions.

As for employee diversity, we actively expand the recruitment of national meritorious persons and foreign nationals. As of the first half of 2022, there were six national meritorious persons and six foreign nationals on our payroll, accounting for 4% of the workforce. We also hire talent on a full-time basis wherever possible, and only two employees (part-time workers), or one percent of the workforce, were non-regular workers during the same period.

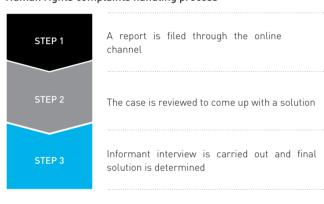

Human rights management

Operating human rights protection channel

JYP Entertainment operates a human rights grievance handling channel in order to prevent workplace harassment, including sexual harassment, and protect the human rights of all employees. The company clearly states in the work rule what constitutes misconduct in the course of employment, and when a concern arises, the responsible team efficiently addresses the issue in accordance with internal regulations and transparently shares the result with the informant.

Human rights complaints handling process



Human rights complaints are handled by the Grievance Committee and Human Resources Committee, which operate independently to ensure adequate protection of informants. When a report is received through the grievance handling channel, the two committees review and investigate the case privately and agree on a solution. Based on this, we consult with the informant and determine on the final solution. The company takes the protection of victims very seriously in this process. We make every effort to protect the informant and maintain confidentiality through the entire process, and ensure victims are not subject to disadvantages or discrimination even after the case is closed.

Human rights education

At JYP Entertainment, company-wide statutory training is conducted every year on sexual harassment prevention, workplace harassment prevention, disability awareness, personal information protection, and ethical management. We consistently emphasize the importance of such training to raise the awareness of human rights among the employees, and we will continue to implement human rights education programs in a systematic way.

Compliance with human rights law

Our continuous effort to conform to the Code of Conduct and protect human rights has resulted in zero violation of human rights law in the past three years (2019 to 2021). We will continue to conduct our business with respect for employees.

Appraisal and compensation system

JYP Entertainment seeks sustainable growth of individual employees and the company by ensuring fair appraisal based on Management By Objectives (MBO). We ensure Leader's Code is embedded in our HR appraisal system and provide employees equal opportunities for promotion, compensation, and benefits.

We foster talent in line with the company's vision by incorporating the six core values in the Leader's Code into the employee assessment category. We implemented the MBO HR program in 2012 to assess individual contributions and performances together with the company's growth objectives, and we have since assisted employees in achieving best performance and personal growth goals. A multi-faceted leadership assessment is conducted as well in order to address improvement gaps based on employee feedback on leaders, and to complement the top-down HR-driven process with the voices of employees. Moreover, we enhance the fairness and transparency of the appraisal system through the Performance Management Committee, which delivers objective appraisals for each organization by carefully looking at the level of performance, environmental difficulty, and stretch goal

setting. The Committee also plays a role in assisting the company in responding to the rapidly changing business landscape by coordinating and adjusting business strategies and goals in a timely manner in alignment with company-wide objectives. The committee members engage in in-depth examination and discussion to enhance the fairness of the appraisal results while striving to promote a culture of communication and engagement across the organization.

At JYP Entertainment, individual employees and the company set the objectives together and compensation is decided by comprehensively considering contributions and performances. By doing so, we ensure fair appraisal and compensation for individual efforts and competencies, without discrimination based on job level, placement, or gender. We are continuously improving compensation to meet employee expectations and motivate performance. Guided by the value of "One JYP Entertainment", we earmark a certain portion of the company's profits and share it with all employees under the company-wide profit sharing plan. This incentive system not only motivates employees to work better, but also is conducive to promoting an environment in which individual employees grow together with the company.

Promoting work-life balance

JYP Entertainment promotes a balanced life for its employees and operates flexible work arrangements and mental well-being programs, taking into account the characteristics of the entertainment industry.

Flexible work arrangements

Taking into consideration the characteristics of the entertainment industry where people work with high levels of autonomy and creativity, we introduced flexible work arrangements. Employees can voluntarily set core work hours depending on the intensity and duties of their work, and fix their own work schedule on a monthly basis. The core time-based flexible work hours, which was implemented before the COVID-19 pandemic, contribute to improving work efficiency and work-life balance.

Mental well-being programs

JYP Entertainment has in place a mental-wellbeing program to promote mental well-being and health of employees. The program consists of face-to-face counseling and online counseling programs with a professional psychologist. The face-to-face counseling is one-on-one sessions, and allows for convenient counseling through video conference or in a separate space.

JYP BOB is an in-house cafeteria serving lunch and dinner on weekdays. Under the slogan "You are what you eat," the restaurant provides all organic meals with the aim of improving employees' health and work productivity, as well as promoting healthy development and positive eating habits of trainees. The restaurant has been operating since July 2, 2018 when the company moved to the current JYP Center in Gangdong, Seoul.



Principles of JYP BOB

• We serve organic, sustainable food.

We mainly use eco-friendly ingredients, including domestic organically grown produce. We're proud to serve a healthy meal even at higher costs than other restaurants.

• We consider health in every step of food preparation.

Our cooking or eating utensils are made with stainless, ceramics, glass, tritan, and silicon, and do not produce environmental hormones. We also use eco-friendly grade 1 dish soaps.

· Safety and hygiene are our top priorities.

Industrial safety & hygiene education is offered to JYP BOB workers every month, and kitchen hygiene education is also conducted regularly. Furthermore, a third-party hygiene check is performed twice a year in our effort to provide clean and safe food.

Horizontal organizational culture

Adopting mutually respectful honorific expression

JYP Entertainment embraces a horizontal organizational culture for employees to communicate freely based on mutual respect, and encourages employees to address each other with the honorific suffix "nim" regardless of job titles instead of honorific titles. This enables employees to communicate horizontally and respect each other without feeling bound by the vertical hierarchy of age or position.

Flexible seating

We have flexible seating arrangements to let members work collaboratively and engage in conversation easily. The flexible seating option allows employees to choose where they want to work, stimulating impromptu encounters and inspiring creativity along the way. In addition, our office zoning gives everyone a functional space, such as focus zone, collaboration space, rest area, and phone booth.

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Employee suggestion program "CHANGE"

"In the creative industry, Success doesn't come from how many hours you put in. Scintillating ideas are the key." – J.Y. Park, 2018, Macquarie Emerging Industries Summit. This describes the nature of the entertainment industry quite well.

In 2022, JYP Entertainment introduced the employee suggestion program called "CHANGE" and established the CHANGE Committee for successful implementation of the new system. Through the CHANGE program, everyone, regardless of their job title or function, can propose opinions that help develop the company or create a happy workplace. When a constructive idea is selected, a taskforce formed under the CHANGE Committee drives its adoption by gathering opinions from each team and developing a detailed execution plan. Diverse ideas and suggestions from employees are incorporated into JYP's work process, programs, and policies, helping to build a better company.



Safe work environment

JYP Entertainment strives to ensure people enjoy our music in a safe environment. To this end, in 2022, we newly formed the safety and health organization and implemented a relevant management system in response to the Industrial Safety and Health Act and Serious Accidents Punishment Act.

Occupational safety and Health

JYP Entertainment conducts risk assessment through a third party company to identify potential risk factors in the workplace, prevent industrial accidents, and ensure a safe environment for our employees. Emergency safety supplies, including fire evacuation masks, are also available to prevent evacuation delays or casualties in the event of a fire.

Additionally, we raise safety awareness through providing statutory training in accordance with the Occupational Safety and Health Act, including generic safety and health training and job-specific training for health and safety managers.

Operating Occupational Safety and Health Committee

JYP Entertainment operates the Occupational Safety and Health Committee as a safety communication channel for a safe working environment. In accordance with the Industrial Safety and Health Act, it convenes on a quarterly basis to deliver and resolve safety and health related matters.

Through operating the Committee, we discuss and address all safety matters, including legal requirements, risk factors in the workplace, and contagious disease prevention, and make continuous efforts to maintain a safe work environment.

Employee health management

JYP Entertainment inspects the physical condition of the workplace for hazard recognition in order to reduce the risk of employees developing a musculoskeletal disorder and promote their health.

In addition, we partner with a personal training facility and dentalclinic and provide comprehensive medical checkups and flu vaccinations to help employees maintain their health.

Ensuring safety for events and performances

For a safe and pleasant event, JYP Entertainment makes sure that everyone on site, including artists and performers, audiences, and staff members, complies with legal safety standards. We carry out continuous and meticulous safety checks from before the onset of the event until after the event finishes.

We will develop emergency response manuals for different crisis situations, such as fire, collapse, and natural disaster, and perform drills in a consistent manner, so as to improve our organizational emergency preparedness. We will also accelerate our effort to foster a safety culture through employee engagement activities, including safety bulletin board as a communication channel and safety campaigns.

A number of creative partners from various fields work together to make and release a piece of music. JYP Entertainment see our partners not just as collaborators, but equal allies sharing growth. We will continue to provide partners with fair and transparent business opportunities as well as a variety of support programs, while driving a mutually beneficial culture.

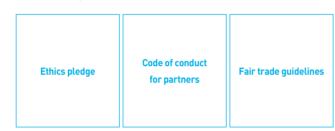

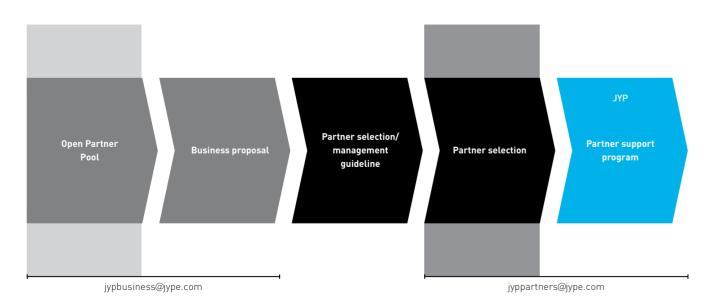

Initial-stage startup investment

JYP Entertainment invests in early-stage companies and small and medium venture businesses through investment associations as a limited partner. Through various innovative investments in the ecosystem, we provide startups with funding for a stable financial position while seeking to create new business opportunities.

The investment associations JYP Entertainment is part of focus on emerging companies and ventures within three years of business, and through investing in those with excellent technology, the associations support their growth and seek strategic ways for mutually beneficial partnerships. Currently, we have investment agreements worth KRW 13 billion through two investment associations, and the total investment made through the two associations is KRW 40.5 billion. As of the end of 2021, we have supported a total of 24 businesses, and we plan to expand our investment in initial-stage startups.

Personal information protection and information security

JYP Entertainment uses its best efforts to protect personal information and securely manage sensitive information. We have implemented an information security system and taken various measures to protect personal information acquired through our business operations as per our privacy protection policy. We will maintain a high level of security so that users can consume JYP Entertainment's contents in a safe environment protected from the threat of data breaches.

Information security system

We maintain 24/7 monitoring of the servers in operation through an information security service provider. Ongoing efforts are made as well to replace security programs or upgrade security control systems. In addition, we control external intrusion utilizing intrusion prevention system, and do our best to be equipped with all possible technological instruments to ensure system security.

In 2022, we plan to roll out the highest level of security program [Microsoft Defender based on CIS/NIST control] to phase in an advanced information security system.

Privacy policy

JYP Entertainment has established and implemented an internal management plan for the safe handling of collected personal information. We are committed to complying with the Privacy Protection Act, the Promotion of the Use of Information and Communication Networks and Protection of Information Act, and all other relevant laws and regulations. We aim to improve company-wide information security awareness through providing employees with information protection training. Over the past three years, a total of 749 employees have received statutory personal information protection training, either online or on-site. Furthermore, we are the only entertainment agency in Korea that conducts cyber threat simulation training for employees jointly with the Korea Internet & Security Agency (KISA) every year. For employees who handle personal information as part of their job, we provide reqular in-house training or external training to help them acquire new security technologies and understand the privacy data protection duty. and in so doing, minimize administrative risk of personal data leakage.

Improving user accessibility

JYP Entertainment is committed to nurturing an environment where users can freely consume our content transcending physical and geographical limitations.

We are focusing on improving the experience for music fans with disabilities who often have difficulty in booking a concert or accessing venue and facilities. For those with limited mobility. accessible tickets are reserved through telephone booking lines, separately from general reservations. We provide two seats for wheelchair users and their companions, and train on-site personnel to support as needed so that they can enjoy the performance to the full. Going forward, we will continue to work to make more accessible and inclusive events by considering various aspects and ensure people with disabilities can enjoy the performances without any inconvenience.

As our stage expands worldwide, we have improved accessibility for overseas users by lowering language barriers. Nowadays our content is consumed not just by domestic fans, but fans across the world - from Japan and China to Southeast Asia. North America. Latin America and Europe. Acknowledging this, we have added Japanese and Chinese language options as well as Korean and English on our company website, and JYP official YouTube channel supports Spanish and various Asian languages including Vietnamese, Thai, and Hindi, making our content more accessible for a wider global audience. In the future, we will further promote accessibility of overseas users through expanding virtual concerts on the Beyond LIVE, an online live performance platform we introduced in 2020.

Expanding digital communication channels

JYP Entertainment believes listening to fans is about connecting with them. We leverage various digital channels to facilitate communication between artists and fans. Artists frequently communicate with their fans by gong live on YouTube, Instagram and other SNS platforms, or using artist-to-fan engagement platforms such as Bubble and V LIVE. Fans can subscribe to the channel of their favorite artists, message them or leave comments. Through this experience, fans can feel a deep sense of connection with the artists beyond boundaries.

For communication with Generation Z, we actively utilize the metaverse platform Zepeto. In the virtual space within the platform, fans meet with JYP artists in a new form of experiential communication, such as taking pictures or practicing choreography together. We also operate JYP Fan's, the official fan community, and use it as an official communication channel with fans. Users may request tickets for TV shows here and get a chance to sit in the audience and see artists in person. As such, various digital channels serve as a reliable means of communication and maximizes user satisfaction

At the company level, we receive various opinions and feedback from fans through JYP Entertainment's official communication email (fan@jype.com), and a marketing manager who is dedicated to communicating with fans is assigned for each artist.

Fan marketing managers constantly monitor domestic and overseas K-Pop markets to gain insights, deliver updates on artists in the fastest and most efficient way, and establish fan engagement strategies tailored to the evolving trend to facilitate communication between fans and artists.

The company defines the communication network for each artist so that various opinions of users are collected and appropriate preemptive actions are taken as needed by fan marketing managers. They also monitor each artist's channel at all times and coordinate communication with fans for TV shows or performances. We strive to better understand what fans want through conducting surveys on fan meetings and surveys.

[ITZY _ LIVE] "Cooking show," on-trend theme for fan engagement

ITZY hosted a special live cooking show with fans on its official YouTube channel for about three months Every Sunday at 6 p.m., starting with the youngest member Yuna, the five members took turns to make the menu recommended by fans, while communicating with them. After the live broadcast finished, an event was held in which fans uploaded their own cooking of ITZY's recipe, and ITZY "liked" the one that has the most resemblance to their dish. Through the cooking show, ITZY not only was able to connect closely with the users of the content, but also created special content for its fandom MIDZY.

At JYP Entertainment, we commit ourselves to upholding the vision "Every Dream Matters!". Through our EDM social contribution activities, we usher in a world where everyone can dream.

Our CSR programs for children and the youth include EDM medical treatment support program and EDM wish granting program, and we engage in various other activities to create a sustainable society, such as employee volunteer activities and local community donations. Since 2020, we have produced EDM DAY video on our EDM social contribution programs at the year-end and posted it on JYP Entertainment's official YouTube channel to share the results with fans and the public. As the flagship project of our CSR activities, EDM medical treatment support program saves precious lives around the world by providing much needed medical expenses to children whose family lives in poverty and cannot afford surgery.

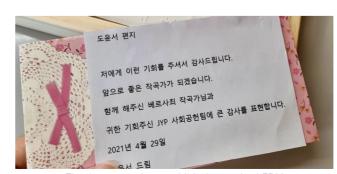
Under the memorandum of understanding (MOU) signed with Samsung Medical Center in August 2020, JYP Entertainment has covered treatment costs for low-income children in Korea, by paying for surgery, orphan drugs, medical devices and treatment (chemotherapy, transplantation, rehabilitation, etc.) for children who suffer from a childhood cancer or rare incurable disease. In 2020 and 2021, our donation totaled KRW 450 million, which benefited 41 children.

Building upon the work, we have expanded the reach of our program worldwide and supported the treatment of children who need our help. In 2021, we signed an MOU with World Vision to start caring for the lives of overseas patients.

Joined also by JYP Japan, our overseas medical treatment support program has saved the lives of 313 overseas children in Mongolia, the Philippines, Bangladesh, and Vietnam.

Local communities

EDM wish granting program

The EDM wish granting program is an emotional support program targeting children aged 3-18 years with an incurable disease at home and abroad. Through the program, we instill them with the power to overcome their disease and the courage to dream by granting them a wish. We signed an MOU with Make a Wish Korea in 2019, and for the period from 2019 to 2021, we donated a total of KRW 790 million to support the dreams of 181 children with incurable diseases.

Through our program, we grant life-changing wishes to children in five categories: "To meet," "To have," "To do," "To go," and "To become". In our effort to grant "To meet" wishes despite the COVID-19 situation, we held an "Online Wish Day" in 2021 for domestic and overseas children who wanted to meet with JYP artists. Through the video calls, artists delivered warm support for the children's fight against critical illness, and children gained unforgettable memory and renewed strength. Wonpil (DAY6), TWICE, Stray Kids, and ITZY participated in this activity to grant the wishes of 11 children with intractable illness.

The EDM wish granting program carries even more special meaning in that fans can also participate together. When they use the JYP Fan's EDM debit card from Shinhan Card, a share of their purchases is automatically donated to EDM social contribution activities. The money collected is then donated in the name of JYP artists and fandom and is used for wish granting for children with incurable diseases.

In addition, domestic and overseas fans can donate directly on our JYP_EDM website, where we operate the "Donation for Children" fundraising with stories of children fighting serious illness and the "EDM Anniversary Donation" fundraising for celebrating meaningful days. As such, JYP Entertainment engages in a wide range of activities on various platforms to spread its "positive influence" with fans.

Expertise and diversity of BOD

JYP Entertainment's executive directors are professionals with multiple years of experience in the entertainment industry. Independent directors consist of experts from various fields, such as accounting, finance, law, and investment. Tapping into its rich experience and knowledge, the BOD deliberates and resolves on its agenda, and efficiently monitors management's activities and performance. In March 2022, a new female independent director was appointed, raising the ratio of female directors in the Board to 25 percent. We will accelerate our efforts to increase the expertise and diversity of the BOD.

Independence of BOD

We ensure that BOD members (excluding Audit Committee members) are independent of the company's largest or major shareholders. We continuously increased the ratio of independent directors, and brought it up to 50 percent with new independent director appointment in 2022, further enhancing the independence of the BOD. The director appointment process requires the company to disclose the personal information of the candidate prior to the shareholders' meeting as well as whether the candidate has any shareholder recommendation.

The BOD deliberates and decides on important management matters in accordance with the Board Operation Guideline, which is constantly reviewed and updated. A resolution of the BOD is made when a majority of the directors are in attendance and by a majority vote of the directors in attendance. In 2021, the BOD convened 10 times to endorse important matters such as establishing subsidiaries and granting stock options.

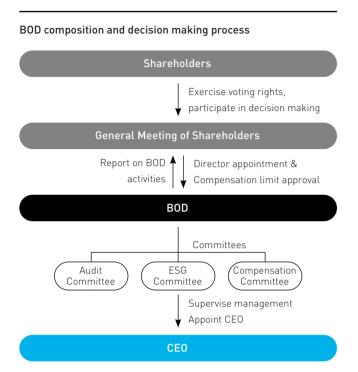

Composition of BOD and Committees



Composition and operation of BOD Committees

The Board of Directors and its subcommittees strive to improve corporate value and maximize shareholder profits. We established the Audit Committee within the BOD for transparent management of the Board, and the Committee consists only of independent directors to ensure its independent decision making. In 2022, we newly established the Compensation Committee and the ESG Committee to strengthen the soundness and sustainability of corporate management.

Audit Committee

The Audit Committee is comprised of all independent directors for its independence, and includes accounting and financial experts in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Commercial Law. The composition, operation and authority, and responsibilities of the Committee are specified in the Audit Committee regulation, which also becomes the guidelines for audit activities. The Audit Committee receives reports from the accounting control manager and is responsible for reviewing the operation status of the internal accounting management system, which is designed to prepare and disclose accounting information in a credible and reliable manner.

Compensation Committee

The Compensation Committee evaluates the management performance and sets the level of compensation for executives accordingly. Going forward, we will establish a balanced and reasonable compensation system and continuously improve it based on mid to long-term profitability and risk projections, ensuring appropriate levels and types of incentives to executives.

ESG Committee

The ESG Committee aims to actively respond to the evolving business landscape and pursue sustainable management. The ESG Committee, which comprises all of independent directors, plays a critical role in decision-making related to ESG activities, such as setting ESG strategic direction and establishing a management roadmap. We have also in place the ESG Council and ESG Taskforce. The ESG Council manages the performance and indicators of ESG projects executed by the Taskforce organization, and reviews and reports various ESG-related agenda to the Committee. The ESG Taskforce sets and executes the ESG visions in alignment with the strategic direction set by the Committee, and drives various ESG activities accordingly.

Compliance Officer

A listed company is required to appoint a compliance officer who meets certain qualifications to ensure the company's business activities fall within legal regulations and internal policies. JYP Entertainment appointed the compliance officer for the first time in 2022. The compliance officer prevents and manages legal risks of the company and ensures business activities are carried out legally and efficiently.

Shareholder-oriented management

Stock and capital structure

JYP Entertainment adopts the "one-share, one-vote" principle. As of December 31 2021, a total of 35,497,492 common shares were issued, and the number of treasury shares that do not carry voting power by the Commercial Law was 2.399,433.

Protecting shareholder rights

We encourage shareholders to exercise their rights at the general shareholders' meeting by sharing significant information in advance wherever we can. In 2020, we introduced an electronic voting system in accordance with relevant law to allow shareholders to cast their vote even when they do not physically attend the shareholders' meeting, enhancing the convenience of shareholders. JYP Entertainment considers the electronic voting system an alternative means that can further strengthen the company's competitiveness by promoting shareholder participation and reducing social cost. Going forward, we will continue to promote electric voting to ensure participation rights of more shareholders.

In addition to the electronic voting system, we became the first in the industry to pay cash dividends as part of our shareholder return policy. We have been implementing the dividend policy since 2018 by comprehensively taking into consideration corporate growth, profit levels, and fund management to improve corporate value and shareholder return together. Furthermore, we transparently disclose stock information, financial statements, disclosures, internal information control regulation, and ethics guideline through IR section of our company website.

Ethical management

Ethics Guideline

JYP Entertainment endeavors to become a trusted company that fulfills its responsibilities and duties as a member of the entertainment industry by complying with laws, ethical standards, and social norms. To that end, we have developed the Ethics Guideline for fair and transparent corporate management, and defined core values and standards of conduct that must be adhered to by all members as a whole to become a respectable company in our society. The Ethics Guideline was revised as of December 1 2021, and its five chapters contain general provisions, fair performance of duty, property and information protection, fan engagement, and self-reporting and reporting.

Ethical management system

Our ethical management system is implemented mainly by HR/General Affairs, Legal, and Accounting that are affiliated with the Management Support Office of the Business Support Division. The system facilitates ethical management and compliance management and promotes compliance value across the organization. In 2022, we plan to further strengthen the ethical management system by facilitating communication between the newly-appointed Compliance Officer and relevant teams.

Ethics training

We conduct ethics management training for all employees as well as new hires. Organized by HR/General Affairs and conducted online once a year, the ethics training aims to promote awareness on the importance of ethical management and its practice, as well as help build an ethical mindset. In 2021, 271 employees received the ethics training and they spent an average of eight hours each doing it. There were no reports of ethics violation received through the hotline.

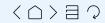

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Materiality Assessment

JYP Entertainment conduct a materiality test to identify and prioritize major sustainability topics based on the Core Option of the GRI Sustainability Reporting Standards and other international ESG evaluation standards. We are committed to regularly conducting sustainability materiality assessments, and sharing the results with stakeholders through this report.

Assessment process

We have identified topics of materials importance by reviewing each issue for business impact and stakeholders' interest.

Step 1. Issue pool creation

We created a pool of 28 issues through analyzing global sustainability standards (i.e., GRI Standards, SASB, and TCFD), ESG indexes (MSCI ESG ratings, KCGS), sustainability issues handled by domestic/overseas peer groups, and media research results.

Step 2. Materiality evaluation of the sustainability issues

We analyzed the 28 issues in the pool on the two criteria as below:

- Business impact: Evaluating the impact each issue may have on JYP Entertainment's reputation, sales and strategy
- Internal data and disclosures/press release screening
- Research on ESG awareness of employees and impact of each issue (Jan to Feb 2022)
- Stakeholder interest: Evaluating the importance of each issue through media research analysis and internal/external stakeholder survey (employees, users, investors, partners, and local communities)
- External stakeholder survey (May 2022)
- Media exposure analysis for the period of June 2021 to May 2022

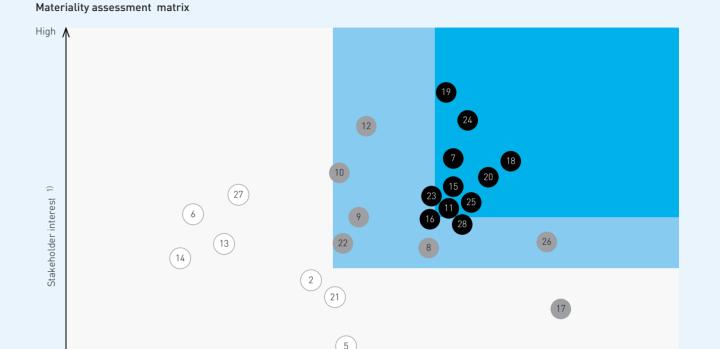
Step 3. Focus issue selection & validation

We selected 11 focus issues based on business impact and stakeholder interest, and reviewed these sustainability issues for their validity through the ESG Taskforce.

Assessment results

A total of 11 sustainability issues were selected as a result of the assessment. Stakeholders were aware of the global expansion of the Korean entertainment industry, and chose "stable development of artists" and "communication with fans" as the key factors directly linked to JYP Entertainment's sustainability.

Given the significant influence partners have on the business, stakeholders highlighted the importance of supplier network management capability in terms of stability. The results of the materiality assessment confirmed the ESG direction and social responsibility required of us, and we reflected in this report our key initiatives and response strategies for each of the highly material issues.

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Independent Assurance Statement

Korea Management Registrar (KMR) was commissioned by JYP Entertainment to conduct an independent assurance of its ESG Report 2021 (the "Report"). The data and its presentation in the Report is the sole responsibility of the management of JYP Entertainment. KMR's responsibility is to perform an assurance engagement as agreed upon in our agreement with JYP Entertainment and issue an assurance statement.

Scope and Standards

JYP Entertainment described its sustainability performance and activities in the Report, Our Assurance Team carried out an assurance engagement in accordance with the AA1000AS v3 and KMR's assurance standard SRV1000. We are providing a Type 2, moderate level assurance. We evaluated the adherence to the AA1000AP (2018) principles of inclusivity, materiality, responsiveness and impact, and the reliability of the information and data provided using the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) Index provided below. The opinion expressed in the Assurance Statement has been formed at the materiality of the professional judgment of our Assurance Team.

Confirmation that the Report was prepared in accordance with the Core Options of the GRI standards was included in the scope of the assurance. We have reviewed the topic-specific disclosures of standards which were identified in the materiality assessment process

- GRI Sustainability Reporting Standards
- Universal standards
- Topic specific standards
- Management approach of Topic Specific Standards
- GRI 412: Human Rights Assessment
- GRI 413: Local Communities

As for the reporting boundary, the engagement excludes the data and information of JYP Entertainment' partners, suppliers and any third parties.

KMR's Approach

To perform an assurance engagement within an agreed scope of assessment using the standards outlined above, our Assurance Team undertook the following activities as part of the engagement:

- reviewed the overall Report:
- reviewed materiality assessment methodology and the assess-
- evaluated sustainability strategies, performance data management system, and processes
- interviewed people in charge of preparing the Report
- reviewed the reliability of the Report's performance data and conducted data sampling
- assessed the reliability of information using independent external sources such as Financial Supervisory Service's DART and public

Limitations and Recommendations

KMR's assurance engagement is based on the assumption that the data and information provided by JYP Entertainment to us as part of our review are provided in good faith. Limited depth of evidence gathering including inquiry and analytical procedures and limited sampling at lower levels in the organization were applied. To address this, we referred to independent external sources such as DART and National Greenhouse Gas Management System (NGMS) and public databases to challenge the quality and reliability of the information provided.

Conclusion and Opinion

Based on the document reviews and interviews, we had several discussions with JYP Entertainment on the revision of the Report. We reviewed the Report's final version in order to make sure that our recommendations for improvement and revision have been reflected. Based on the work performed, it is our opinion that the Report applied the Core Option of the GRI Standards. Nothing comes to our attention to suggest that the Report was not prepared in accordance with the AA1000AP (2018) principles.

Inclusivity

JYP Entertainment has developed and maintained different stakeholder communication channels at all levels to announce and fulfill its responsibilities to the stakeholders. Nothing comes to our attention to suggest that there is a key stakeholder group left out in the process. The organization makes efforts to properly reflect opinions and expectations into its strategies.

Materiality

JYP Entertainment has a unique materiality assessment process to decide the impact of issues identified on its sustainability performance. We have not found any material topics left out in the process.

Responsiveness

JYP Entertainment prioritized material issues to provide a comprehensive, balanced report of performance, responses, and future plans regarding them. We did not find anything to suggest that data and information disclosed in the Report do not give a fair representation of JYP Entertainment actions.

Impact

JYP Entertainment identifies and monitors the direct and indirect impacts of material topics found through the materiality assessment, and quantifies such impacts as much as possible.

Reliability of Specific Sustainability Performance Information

In addition to the adherence to AA1000AP (2018) principles, we have assessed the reliability of economic, environmental, and social performance data related to sustainability performance. We interviewed the in-charge persons and reviewed information on a sampling basis and supporting documents as well as external sources and public databases to confirm that the disclosed data is reliable. Any intentional error or misstatement is not noted from the data and information disclosed in the Report.

Competence and Independence

KMR maintains a comprehensive system of quality control including documented policies and procedures in accordance with ISO/IEC 17021-2015 - Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems. This engagement was carried out by an independent team of sustainability assurance professionals. KMR has no other contract with JYP Entertainment and did not provide any services to JYP Entertainment that could compromise the independence of our work.
